BAUBIGNY SCHOOLS – PATHWAY AROUND THE FOOTBALL PITCH Suggestions for enhancements in the area



Beginning of the walk: We need to mow a path diagonally through the two wildflower meadows to the fence from the vehicle track.



Dig a small run off douit parallel with the southern fence to allow water from the path to run away. Plant colourful/natural wildlife shrubs to act as a wind break and to add enhancement.



The thick hedgerow and trees along the west section provides a wind break. Further enhancements with trees and shrubs. The path around the pitch will need mowing regularly.



Final north approach to the car park – more planting – a mini woodland area with more shrubs which will cut out a lot of costly maintenance.



Near the car park. This section should be enhanced to provide a picnic area for outside education for children and for parents waiting to collect their children.



We need a diagonally mowed path from the fence to the new opening into the car park to provide a short cut. Also create a visual guiding entrance with shrubs and flowers to help all the users of this fantastic walk.
