

# THE LIVING STREETS TRANQUILLITY WALK

Sunday 25th September – 2.00 p.m.

## A 1.45 hour walking challenge through the lanes and green lanes in the parish of the Forest

In June 2007 Living Streets started campaigning for a safe route to the Baubigny Schools through the beautiful countryside for students coming from St. Peter Port. The States is not financially supporting the development of this route. However, with the support of Guernsey businesses and individual islanders we managed to raise sufficient funds to open up the route in September 2010. But we still need funds every year to pay for the rental agreement with the landowner of the viney site through which the pathway goes. The Tranquillity Walk helps us raise the funds to keep the pathway up and running for future generations.

### Information for walkers

The walk will include lanes, Ruettes Tranquilles and green lanes in the Forest, including the lovely hamlet Le Variouf. There are two options where you can short cut back to the start if you find the walk too challenging.

Starts: 2.00 p.m. at the Forest Stores car park, Le Bourg.

**Registration will be from 1.30 to 2.00 pm. Adults £5, children under 16 go free. Dogs are welcome on leads.**

### Safety

We recommend suitable walking shoes/boots. Parents will be expected to ensure children are wearing sensible shoes. Please check the weather forecast and come with suitable clothing e.g. sun hats, sun glasses and sunshield etc. if it is a hot day. **Please bring your own water.** Wet weather clothing if it is raining. **Please note that the green lanes are not suitable for buggies and prams.**

### Be green and come by bus:

Bus routes 91, 92, 93, 94 and 95 all stop at Le Bourg from Town via Trinity Square and St. Martin. In the other direction you have the 92 round island bus, 93 from L'Eree that stop at Le Bourg and 71 from Town via the Grange and St. Andrew that stops at the Airport.
